As we recall the 'transfigurations' we have seen, we gain some insight into our spiritual and religious experiences. We can treasure each of these when they occur and we can say, 'It is good for us to be here.' Like the

Transfiguration of Jesus on the mountain, these experiences do not last. After a while we have to come back down to our ordinary lives. So our question, then, is this: Where do we place our trust?
