**Broadway Here We Come! - "Raising The Roof",  
musical and fundraiser**

**April 25, 26, 27, 1985**

Fundraising to cover infrastructure debt has always been a vital and vibrant activity at Sacred Heart Parish. Christmas Bazaars, Spaghetti Dinners, Penny Sales, Turkey Rolls, and special Dinner Dances have greatly and positively supported this endeavor. However, there has never been a fundraiser that involved more of our parishioners and community, and that produced more fun than that of the variety show- "Raising the Roof". Parish members Gus and Pat LoPresti volunteered to direct and produce this variety show.

Not only did people from our own parish come forward to offer their time and talents, but other people from other parishes volunteered to participate as performers, stage crew, sound and light crew, make-up artists, costume creators, ticket and promotion advertisers, and video producers. Regular scheduled rehearsals occurred, and the show was booked at St Thomas More High School auditorium (the original one behind Sts. Peter and Paul Elementary School.) Tickets were \$4.00 for each show. Opening night was April 25<sup>th</sup>, 8pm. There was an M.C., a "Men's Ballet", a "Shirley Temple", a "Charlie Chaplin", a "Kate Smith", and two sets of "Andrew Sisters". The all-inclusive cast of laity and clergy, young and old, mesmerized and delighted the audiences. The show was a great success, and raised \$4,000.

Word spread throughout Hamilton of this spectacular event. St. Joseph's Building Fund asked the LoPrestis to put on a show for them. Then came "Raising the Roof II", and "Raising the Roof III". These shows were presented at Mohawk College Theatre, and were all sell outs! Sacred Heart Parishioners, friends, and community members shared their talents in having fun and fundraising.
