### Rearview Mirror

I have found that God’s providence is seen most clearly in the rearview mirror. I can see God acting in my life after the fact - the “chance” meeting, the difficult challenge, the wise counsel. God’s will for us is often more difficult to recognize in the present, torn between choices, buffeted by fear and selfishness.

The Scripture readings today focus on doing the will of God. In the gospel, Jesus, gives us an instructive lesson in his rebuke of Peter’s outburst. Only a few verses after Peter recognizes Jesus as the Messiah, he tries to dissuade Jesus from his prediction of the Passion.

Jesus is reminding all of us that, so often, we are thinking not as God does, but as humans do. We want the easy path, the broad road. Jesus wants us to take up our cross. What was not easily seen until later was that that sacrifice, that cross, was God’s will, and what was difficult was also a blessing.
