**Farmers' Market: Sharing "Fruits of the Earth"  
With Parishioners and the Community**

The Hamilton Mountain Farmers' Market was Chuck Emberson's inspiration for Sacred Heart Parish in 2007. The impetus was to bring parishioners and the community together in the time treasured venue of a farmers' market. Chuck has been the chair of the Mountain Farmers' Market subcommittee and market organizer since the beginning. The market runs from June until late October, and produce sold varies with the growing season. The market is held in the parking lot of Sacred Heart Church at Viewpoint and Mountain Park Avenue. For twelve years the market was held on Saturdays, but now runs on Friday 3:30-7:30 pm and the attendance has grown even larger. This year, together with produce, there is the addition of a craft brewery (Grimsby), and Crumbuns Bakeshop Concession Street. This market has proven to be a great place to purchase local products, and to meet up with fellow parishioners and friends from the mountain area. Sacred Heart Parish continues to thrive as the "community with a heart".
