Jesus said to them, "Come have breakfast." John 21:12

In Today's passage from John's Gospel, we see Jesus embody the spaciousness of heart so integral to a spirit of hospitality and welcome. This charming scene echoes of the Eucharistic meal at the Last Supper.

After pointing out to the disciples a place of abundant fishing beyond their limited imagining, Jesus waits on shore to welcome them as community and to invite the laying down of their burdens. He prepares a meal on a charcoal fire over which the simple element of everyday life, fish and bread, have been placed with love. He longs to welcome the weary disciples to a feast full of gratitude and hope.

At our celebration of Eucharist, we reenact this time of feeding and tending and gathering in community at a table of love set by Jesus. Now as then, he invites us to come and enter into this sacred meal in all its fullness and richness.
