100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary 1921-2021  
History Factoid 14**

Father George Palamattam, as Pastor, led our Sacred Heart Parish congregation with God's message and words from July 1, 2012 until June 30, 2015. He oversaw much infrastructure work during this time. The church and altar floors were replaced, a repose altar was built, and a new washroom installed at the church entrance. To accommodate masses and other liturgical gatherings, Casa Maria and also the school gym were used during this time of renovation. This project was a large endeavor but one that updated and beautified our Sacred Heart church building. To defray the costs of these church renovations much fundraising was done, and loans were soon repaid. Very devoted to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, Father George created a beautiful prayer to the Sacred Heart of Jesus that parishioners prayed regularly. To build community, Father George regularly invited parishioners to barbecues after mass. Father George was also passionate about gardening and many colorful flowers and plants brightened the church grounds. He was also a budding chef and often wonderful scents wafted from the rectory. Father George served Sacred Heart Parish with deep faith for three years, and was then reassigned to Prince Edward Island.

Father Saju Oreethaparambil became administrator of Sacred Heart Parish for one year (July 1, 2015- June 30, 2016). During his stay at Sacred Heart we were blessed his great commitment to God. There were many Holy Hour Devotions, Healing Masses, and his special prayers for parishioners ill or in need of blessings. He was also privileged to oversee the Legion of Mary. Pope Francis proclaimed the year 2015 the Year of Mercy. We were privileged at Sacred Heart Parish to be designated as a Pilgrimage site. Many prayers and devotions were celebrated in our church throughout the year to honor this Year of Mercy. Because of Father Saju's initiative and efforts a much needed and updated sound system was installed. We thank Father Saju for so humbly, with prayerful praise, bringing us the healing, and strength of our Risen Lord.
