### Catholic students, staff and parents walk in the 16<sup>th</sup> Annual Pilgrimage

More than 3,000 students and staff from the Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School will set out on the 16th annual “Walk with Christ: Justice for the Poor” Pilgrimage on Sunday, Oct 20<sup>th</sup> in support of development projects in Haiti, Uganda and the Dominican Republic.

“Walk with Christ: Justice for the Poor” is an annual board-wide fundraiser which, since 2004, has raised more than \$600,000 for development projects in the Global South. This year the walk will support ADESJO (Association for the Development of San José de Ocoa) for the construction of schools, homes, hospitals, roads and irrigation systems in the Dominican Republic; St. Genevieve Parish in Haiti for construction of a new St. Francis of Assisi church/school building in the remote village of Tifton; the Kankobe Children's Home in Uganda for building renovations, and the education and care of 120 vulnerable orphan children; and the Holy Child Association for development projects in Nabilatuk Parish, Uganda.

The pilgrimage will begin with a Eucharistic celebration at **Cathedral High School** at 30 Wentworth Street North at **11:00 a.m.** sharp, followed by an 8-kilometre walk at approximately **12:00 p.m.** up the Wentworth escarpment trail to **St. Anthony Daniel Catholic Elementary School** on Anson Avenue.
